### Get the Most Out of It

Before we dive in, let's make one thing clear: While gaining knowledge from scripture is important, it alone won't transform your character or deepen your relationship with Christ. The real key is **putting that biblical knowledge into action**. This is how you unlock God's power, change hearts, and truly change lives (see **John 8:31-32**).

This study method is designed so that you discover the answers in the **Scriptures themselves**, guided by the Holy Spirit and with the support of a friend on your faith journey. Taking shortcuts or not paying attention will **diminish the impact of this study**, robbing you of the opportunity to deepen your understanding and relationship with God.

Here are some key points to help you get the most out of this booklet series:

**Mentorship Study Approach:** We recommend using this as a mentorship study approach. **Finding a mentor** who has completed this series can provide valuable support. These booklets are designed to spark meaningful discussions and help build godly relationships. Forming friendships through shared study will enrich your spiritual journey (see references in Matthew 28:20, John 21:17, Galatians 6:6). If you're struggling to find a mentor, reach out to us. We host many online sessions and are eager to assist you on your journey.

**Pray:** Always begin your study by praying. **Invite God, through His Holy Spirit**, to open your mind and heart as you engage with the material.

Read the Scriptures: It's crucial to use your Bible to read the relevant passages before answering the questions (see Romans 10:17). Engaging directly with God's Word will strengthen your ability to **handle it independently**, without relying solely on others. We all need to learn to stand on our own spiritual feet.









**Your Opinion Doesn't Count:** When you answer the questions, always **find your answers in the Bible**. Even if you think you know the answer, start by searching the Scriptures. In this study, your personal opinions don't matter; only what is written in God's Word matters. This study is about resetting your understanding based on what scripture actually teaches (see 2 Timothy 4:3). It's your responsibility to protect yourself from false teachings and religious opinions.

**Scripture's Answer Counts:** Complete all the answers in the booklet based on the actual scripture. Sometimes the answers are simple, but the challenge lies in practising them. Engage in discussions with your study partner to grasp what the Scriptures truly convey, and approach this with humility.

**Be Vulnerable:** Be honest with yourself, even if it's uncomfortable. Personal questions can be challenging because they test how you apply scripture in your life. Remember the saying, **"no pain, no gain."** When you meet with your study partner, have a "follow-up conversation" about how you applied the teachings. We're all on this journey and fall short in many ways. That's why it's often best not to study in large groups, as it can hinder vulnerability and the power of this study.

Memory Verse: Always work on **memorizing a verse**. This helps keep your mind focused on God and His will, especially in a world filled with distractions.

**Share** your journey: Deliberately share what you learn with someone, and don't get discouraged when others don't share your experience. God will use our humble and gentle conversations to encourage others to grow in their relationship with Him. He loves us all, and His patience is infinite.

I hope you find great joy in this series, and may it be an eternal source of encouragement on your spiritual journey.

Elementary teaching helps Christians or Spiritual people evaluate their maturity to grow and become effective in God's kingdom.

Understanding where you are on the maturity journey is key to deepening your walk with Christ. Use this roadmap as a guide to help you focus on areas that need growth, and share your experiences with others.

**Reflection**: Do you ever feel that even after being a Christian for many years, you are still ill-equipped and unenabled to do God's work?

Working through these scriptures and answering the questions below can give insight into what spiritual maturity means. It will give you a growth plan and something you can share with the people around you. Sadly, many Christians today do not know these basic but essential teachings.

Please read the story of my journey as I grew in humility, knowledge and faith. The cracks in my life did not show up until later. Don't be fooled by life's honeymoon period! What is shocking is that after so many years of being exposed to mature church teaching, so many of us are still struggling with what is defined as elementary teaching. Faulty foundations often only become visible after many years. Initially, the house appears well until the first crack appears. Does a crack not tell us that all is not well?

## **MEMORY VERSE**

Don't try to learn all the memory verses at once; select only one or two verses each week. Go at a pace that doesn't add too much pressure on yourself and others. You will find new meaning to the scriptures you memorize.



Heb 6:1 Therefore let us leave the elementary teachings about Christ and go on to maturity, not laying again the foundation of repentance from acts that lead to death, and of faith in God, 2 instruction about baptisms, the laying on of hands, the resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment. 3 And God permitting, we will do so.
