The way to the Father

Joh 14:6 Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and ...read all.

How many ways are there to the Father and through whom?

Visualize Jesus as the only Mediator

Draw God as creator, king, almighty and father at the top of the page.


Split the page in two. On the left hand side draw the cross, a king (this represents the Jesus Christ as the mediator to God – Joh 14:6).

On the right-hand side draw a scull (this represents the dead such as Mary, saints, our ancestors, and other spirits as mediator - 1Ti 2:5-6; Isa 8:19).

At the bottom of the page draw Believers and connect them with the lines through both left and right to God.

On the right-hand line write Sin and on the left-hand line draw righteousness.

Visualize Jesus's Character

In the middle top of the page, draw a sun in all its brilliance with a face inside (this represents Jesus Christ in all his brilliance – Rev 1:12-18). Draw his hair as white as snow and crown on his head with a sash in his hand, blazing eyes and his words like a sword.



Split the bottom page in three.


On the left-hand side draw the cross, with a spirit on the cross (this represents the false doctrine of Jesus Christ not in the flesh – 2Jn 1:7-9).

In the middle draw a man with a staff (this represents the false teaching that Jesus was a prophet - Mat 16:13-16).

On the right-hand side draw a angel (this represent the false teaching that Jesus was one of the angle of God - Heb 1:5-10)

Cross out the spirit, a prophet and Angel as representations of Jesus Character.






SALVATION
