



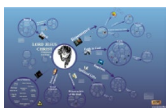

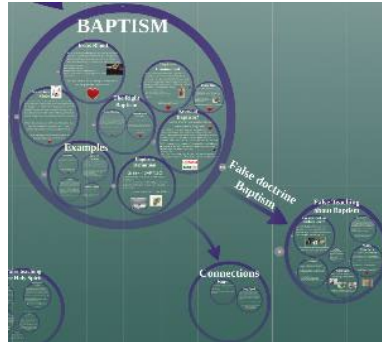

Luk 23:42 Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when ...read all

False statement: Jesus forgiving the sins of the thief invalidates the need for baptism

Did the thief die under the old or new covenant?

Heb 9:15 For this reason Christ is the mediator of a newread all

How were people's sins forgiven under the old covenant?

Heb 9:15-18 For this reason Christ is the mediator of a new ...read all

When did the new covenant come into effect?

Mat 9:6 But so that you may know that the Son of Man hasread all

Did Jesus only forgive the thief's sins on the cross while on earth?

Mat 28:19 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations,read all

Old Testament & False Doctrine

Act 2:36 "Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah." Act 2:37 When the people heard this, they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and the other apostles, "Brothers, what shall we do?" Act 2:38 Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Mar 16:16 Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.

Rom 6:3 Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? 4 We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.
