Add the heading "1Co 13:4-8 - TESTING YOUR FRUIT"

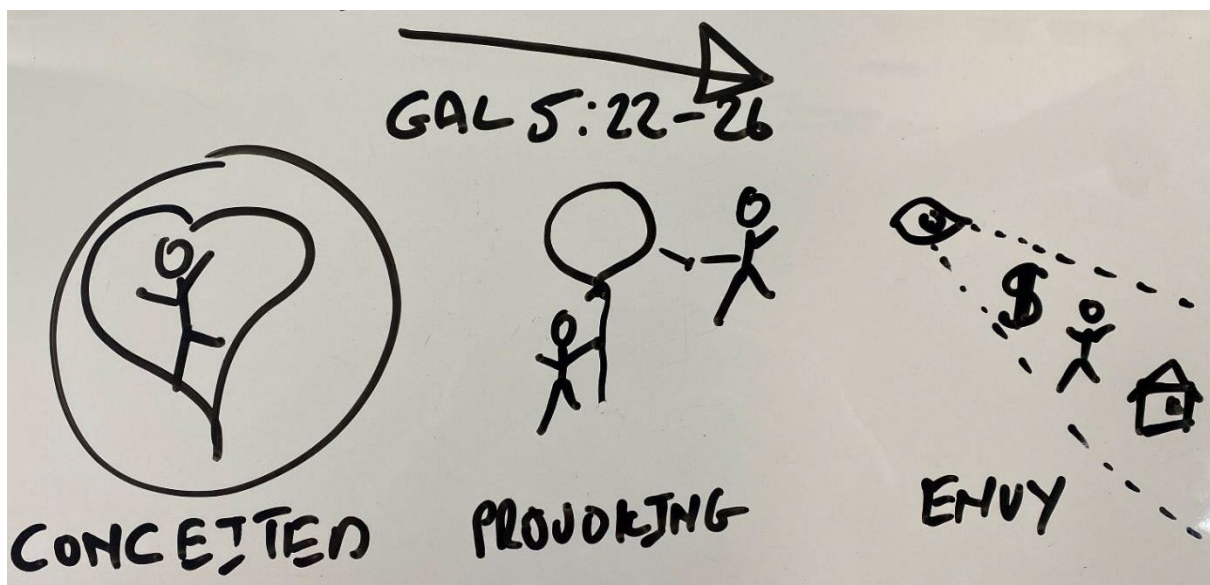


1. Conceited: Draw a **circle with a heart and draw yourself inside the heart** (showing a disciple that is focused on themselves and their own abilities. A disciple that is thinking more of themselves than of others).
2. Provoking: Draw someone about to **pop someone else's balloon** (showing a disciple that always causes conflict, tempting others to become angry or upset.)
3. Envy: Draw an **eye that is obsessed with other things** (showing a disciple that desires what others have).

What does someone look like that is provoking?

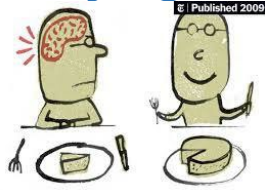
1. to anger, enrage, exasperate, or vex.

Memory verse

Don't try and learn all the memory verses at once, but only select one or two verses each week. Go at a pace that doesn't add too much pressure on yourself and others. You will find new meanings in the scriptures you memorise.

Gal 5:16 So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.

1Co 13:4 Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. 5 It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. 6 Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. 7 It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.

Gal 5:22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. 24 Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. 25 Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit. 26 Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other.

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NEXT

We are now in the heart of Christianity, the Holy Spirit. Walking in step with the Holy Spirit gives us access to the power of God which transforms our lives.

Next, we'll explore the topic "**Holy Spirit – Gifts.**" There are many teachings that minimize the working of gifts and other teachings that teach a distorted view of the gifts. Either way, we are not in control of what the Holy Spirit does and need to be careful that we don't deny the power of the Holy Spirit or teach a superstitious teaching about the Holy Spirit.
