









Don't be hasty





Old Testament

Hebrew meaning

Originate from Hebrew - "rely on" or "to be authorized"

ALSO MEANS

Semikhah (Hebrew: "leaning [of the hands]"),

Semichut (Hebrew: "ordination"),

Semicha lerabbanut (Hebrew: "rabbinical ordination")
