OLD TESTAMENT

Hebrew meaning

Originate from Hebrew - "rely on" or "to be authorized" ALSO MEANS Semikhah (Hebrew: "leaning [of the hands]"), Semicha lerabbanut (Hebrew: "rabbinical ordination")

H6942 Hallow/ Become Holy

qadash - קַדַש



(872d); denom. vb. from H6944; *to be set apart* or *consecrated*: — become consecrated (2), become holy (1), dedicate (2), keep it holy (2), prepare (2), prove myself holy (2), purified (1), sanctified (9), set them apart (1), treated as holy (1), vindicate the holiness (1).

H1288 Abundantly Bless

barak - בָּרַך

(138c); a prim. root; *to kneel, bless*: — abundantly bless (1), boast (1), congratulates (1), curse (3), greet (2), salute (1), thanked (1).

H6680 Commissioned/ Command

tsavah - צָוָה

(845b); a prim. root; to lay charge (upon), give charge (to), command, order: — appoint (1), charge (5), (1), command (56), commission (3), commit (1), gave orders (2), laid down (1), ordained (4), put (1), sent.









H3722a Forgave

kaphar - כָּפַר

(497b); denom. vb. from H3724a; *to cover over, pacify, make propitiation*: — appease (1), appease *(1), atone (3), canceled (1), expiation can be made (1), forgave (1), pardon (1).

H4886 – Spread Oil

mashach - מְשֵׁח

(602d); a prim. root; **to smear**, anoint: — anoint (21), oil (1), painting (1), spread (4).



Blessings (barak)

Gen 27:1-41 When Isaac was old and his eyes were so ... read all

Gen 27:30 After Isaac finished blessing him, and Jacob had scarcely left his father's presence, his brother Esau came in from hunting. Why was the blessing so important to Rebekah and Jacob?

Are you eager for a blessing from God?

What should we do to be blessed by Jesus?









Consecration (qadash)

Exo 29:1 "This is what you are to do to consecrate them ...read all

Exo 29:15 "Take one of the rams, and Aaron and hisread all What happened when they put their hands on the head of a ram?

Anoint (mashach)

1Sa 16:13 So Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed ...read all How do you use your hands when anointing someone?

Why was it necessary to anoint David?

Ordaining for service (tsavah)

Num 11:16-25 The LORD said to Moses: "Bring meread all Num 11:17 I will come down and speak with you there, and I will take some of the power of the Spirit that is on you and put it on them. They will share the burden of the people with you so that you will not have to carry it alone.

Num 27:18-20 So the LORD said to Moses, "Take Joshua a son of Nun, a man in whom is the spirit of leadership, and **lay your hand on him**.

Annual day of atonement (kapha)

Lev 16:21 He is to lay both hands on the head of the ...read all

What was the atonement referring to?

Heb 2:17 For this reason he had to be made like them ...read all Judgement

Lev 24:14 "Take the blasphemer outside the camp. All ... read all

Did you also receive these gifts? How did you receive the gift of the Holy Spirit?


1Ti 4:14 Do not neglect your gift, which was given you ...read all Who laid their hands on Timothy? Was an apostle part of the group?


