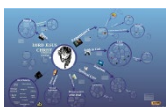

How to get the most out of this booklet

Putting biblical knowledge into practice is the key, that teaches truth and the power of God, which in turn changes hearts and lives. (John 8:31-32). - Always have a memory verse you are working on.
- It is a good idea to share what you are learning with a friend.

anastasis (an-as'-tas-is)

From [G450](#); a standing up again, that is, (literally) **a resurrection from death** (individual, general or by implication (its author)), or (figuratively) a (moral) recovery (of spiritual truth): - raised to life again, resurrection, rise from the dead, that should rise, rising again. Total KJV occurrences: 42
