





This teaching method is fun, and people from all literacy levels can practice becoming a teacher in their local community. Draw the following:

Divide the page into three horizontal sections.

Top section: Jesus on the Cross (Psa 16:8-11), His burial (Pet 3:20-22), resurrection (Luk 24:1-9, 11:21-44), flame (Rom 8:9-11) and unity with God (Joh 16:4-15).


Middle section: old man (Act 26:22-24), baptised in water (Rom 6:1-7 represent united in the death of Christ Jesus), and resurrected into a new life through the spirit.

Bottom section: man going to the grave, resurrected and scales (represent giving account on the day of judgement, Rev 20:11-15).

### 2. Jesus Died According to No Christian Sources

Josephus (AD 37-100) Roman Jewish Historian

In "Antiquities of the Jews," there is a passage known as the Testimonium Flavianum, which mentions Jesus. The passage, in its most commonly cited form, states:

"Now there was about this time Jesus, a wise man, if it be lawful to call him a man, for he was a doer of wonderful works, a teacher of such men as receive the truth with pleasure. He drew over to him both many of the Jews and many of the Gentiles. He was [the] Christ. And when Pilate, at the suggestion of the principal men amongst us, had condemned him to the cross, those that loved him at the first did not forsake him, for he appeared to them alive again the third day, as the divine prophets had foretold these and ten thousand other



wonderful things concerning him. And the tribe of Christians, so named from him, are not extinct at this day."

Ticitus (AD 56-117) Roman senator/historian

The Roman historian and senator Tacitus referred to Jesus, his execution by Pontius Pilate, and the existence of early Christians in Rome in his final work, Annals (written c. AD 116), book 15, chapter 44.[1]

The context of the passage is the six-day Great Fire of Rome that burned much of the city in AD 64 during the reign of Roman Emperor Nero.[2] The passage is one of the earliest non-Christian references to the origins of Christianity[broken

Visualise Elementary Teachings - Repentance

In the center page draw a cross and write "Elementary Teachings Jesus Christ," and RESURRECTION (1Co 15).

Bottom middle draw a skeleton raised to life (Representing resurrection).

Top left draws a brain (Repentance, Act 26:22-24 which represents the change of mind required for belief in resurrection).

Top center draw a heart and "God" (Represent Faith, Col 2:11-12 faith in the resurrection).

Top right draw a man going in and out of water (Repentance, Act 26:22-24 which represents the change of mind required for belief in resurrection).

Bottom left draw a flame (Holy Spirit, Rom 8:9-11, represents power of the Holy Spirit during resurrection).

Bottom right draw a scale (Eternal judgement, Rev 20:11-15, represent power of the Holy Spirit during resurrection).



Don't try and learn all the memory verses at once but only select one or two verses each week. Go at a pace that doesn't add too much pressure on yourself and others. You will find new meaning to the scriptures you memorise.

In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, 4 and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade. This inheritance is kept in heaven for you, 5 who through faith are shielded by God's power until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time.

Jo 11:25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; 26 and whoever lives by believing in me will never die. Do you believe this?"

1Pe 3:20 to those who were disobedient long ago when God waited patiently in the days of Noah while the ark was being built. In it only a few people, eight in all, were saved through water, 21 and this water symbolises baptism that now saves you also—not the removal of dirt from the body but the pledge of a clear conscience toward God. It saves you by the resurrection of Jesus Christ, 22 who has gone into heaven and is at God's right hand—with angels, authorities and powers in submission to him

Php 3:10 I want to know Christ--yes, to know the power of his resurrection and participation in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, 11 and so, somehow, attaining to the resurrection from the dead. 1Co 15:51 Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed-- 52 in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.
