

INTRODUCTION

Before we begin it is important to emphasize that gaining scriptural knowledge in itself, though important, is not enough to change character. Putting biblical knowledge into practice is the key, that teaches truth and the power of God which in turn changes hearts and lives. (John 8:31-32). The study is structured in a way that you will write out the scriptures yourselves for the purposes of deeper reflection. Here are some key points on how to get the most out of the booklet:

- Read the scriptures before answering the questions (really important)! . In this way you will learn to know the word of God.
- Always find the answer from the Bible. Although you might think you know the answer, first find the answer in the Bible.
- Complete all the answers on the booklet.
- Be very honest with yourself, even if it hurts.
- Always have a memory verse you are working on.
- It is a good idea to share what you are learning with a friend.





THE JUDGEMENT



✓ VISUALIZE JUDGEMENT



Here is the meaning of the symbols in the drawing:

JUDGE

God Heart (God as judge – Rev 20:11-15), Cross and crown (Christ as judge – Isa 11:1-5; Joh 5:22-23), Flame (Holy Spirit) believers as judges, Believers (Acting as judges – 1Co 6:2-3).

WHAT

Cross and crown (Rejection of in Christ Jesus – Joh 12:46-50), Bible (Rejection of the Words of God), draw a Heart (Love - Luk 10:27),

Draw two scroll. First Scroll (Condemnation because of our Deeds – Rev 20:11-15), Second scroll two (Salvation by the blood of Christ Jesus)

HOW

Eye (Exposing our deeds by the light of God – Joh 3:19-21), Heart with a white and dark side (Judge us on our motive – 1Co 4:5), heart with a cross inside (the mercy we show others – 2:12-13)

WHERE

On the top right corner draw a son in all its brilliance (God's consuming holiness and heaven – Joh 5:22-23).

On the left bottom corner draw a fire with people inside the fire (Second death/ hell – Rev 20:15/ Mat 10:25-28)

WHO - BELIEVER

Starting at the top right of the page, draw a man with a flame on top of his head (saved disciple/ believer – 1Pet 4:17-18). Draw a thick arrow pointing to the son/ heaven (believers with their names in the book of life).

Draw a dotted arrow to the left of the believer pointing to a fire (Second death/ hell – Rev 20:15).


To the left of the believer draw a cross that is crossed out (believers that fallen away/ rejected Christ Jesus – Heb 6:1-6), shooting target (Heb 10:26-31), sleeping man (Mat 25:14-30) and fire that is crossed out (man sinned against Holy Spirit by insulting the work of the Holy Spirit – Mat 12:22-32).

WHO - UNBELIEVER

In the middle of the page, draw a man with a arrow pointing to the fire (man that does not know God and disobeyed the gospel message having given the opportunity - 2Th 1:8-10), write ABC (careless words that condemned the man – Mat 12:36-37).

WHO - IGNORANT

Bottom middle of the page, draw a man with arrow to hell and heaven (Someone that never had the opportunity to hear the gospel), heart (person conscience and law on his heart – Rom 2:14-16), earth and stars (creation that inspired the ignorant to worship God)



Don't be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows.
