Putting biblical knowledge into practice is the key, as it teaches truth and the power of God, which in turn changes hearts and lives. (John 8:31-32). The study is structured in a way that you will write out the scriptures yourselves for the purposes of deeper reflection. Here are some key points on how to get the most out of the booklet:

- Read the scriptures before answering the questions (fundamental)! This is how you will learn to know the word of God.
- Always find the answer from the Bible. Although you might think you know the answer, first find the answer in the Bible.









- Complete all the answers in the booklet.
- Be very honest with yourself, even if it hurts.
- Always have a memory verse you are working on.
- Sharing what you are learning with a friend is a good idea.

In his famous Sermon on the Mount, Jesus introduces a teaching of rewards that reflects God's character. Let's see what these promises are.




Misthos (mis-thos')

Apparently a primary word; pay for service (literally or figuratively), good or bad: - hire, reward, wages.

- Mat 5:1 Now when he saw the crowds, he went up on a mountainside and sat down. His disciples came to him, 2 and he began to teach them, saying:
- 3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 4 Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.
- 5 Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.
- 6 Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.
- 7 Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy.
- 8 Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.
- 9 Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called sons of God.
- 10 Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 11 "Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me.
- 12 Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you.



☐ What is good about a reward?
A reward is a recognition of faithfulness and perseverance, which encourages us to remain steadfast in doing good. It reflects God's justice and generosity.

The reward could be eternal life, closeness to God, joy in seeing others saved through our influence, and treasures in heaven.

If not, why do you think that is? What steps can you take to nurture a deeper connection with God's promises?










3.2. Heavenly Destination

Rev 21:21-27 The twelve gates were twelve pearls, ...read all.

Drawing Instructions:

<u>Surrounding all</u>, draw God's temple, the city, a solid pearl gate and streets made of shining gold, labelled "City of God", Rev 21:21-27 (This represents the new city of all whose name was written in the Book of Life dwell).

The beauty of the new city, the absence of pain and sorrow, living eternally with God, and being in the presence of Jesus forever. There will be perfect peace, joy, and unity with God's people.








3.3. Jesus Prepare a Place for You

📜 Joh 14:1-4 "Do not let your hearts be troubled....read all.

Drawing Instructions:

Draw the people in the city, rooms and houses, labelled "Disciples", Joh 14:1-4, Mat 6:19-20 that represent those whose names are written in the Book of Life, as well as the treasures we have stored up in heaven through helping others come into the kingdom of God.



Why is Jesus going to the FATHER?


Jesus is going to the Father to prepare a place for His followers in heaven, securing an eternal home for them where they will be with Him forever.

HEART QUESTIONS: Are you concerned about where you are going?

(Some might feel uncertain about their eternal destination, but Jesus reassures us that if we trust in Him, we can have peace about where we are going.)

In what ways can you accept and show Jesus' love more fully in your life this week?

(Accepting Jesus' love means trusting Him fully, embracing His sacrifice, and living according to His teachings. It's the foundation of our salvation.)









4. HEAVEN ACTIVITIES

4.1. A Place of Worship

Rev 15:4 Who will not fear you, ... read all.

Drawing Instructions:

Draw people worshipping before God, and write "Worship" (representing those rewarded by God).



What are some of God's righteous acts?

God's righteous acts include His creation, salvation through Jesus, His justice, mercy, faithfulness to His promises, and His ultimate plan for redemption.


HEART QUESTIONS:

Are you moved in your heart to worship God's righteous acts?

(Consider whether you understand God's righteousness and His works and whether they lead to a response of worship, gratitude, and awe in your life.)

Why, why not? What can you do about it?

(If someone isn't moved, it could be due to a lack of understanding or connection with God. To change this, they could spend more time reflecting on God's deeds, praying, and studying His Word.)









4.2. Reign with Christ

The Bible teaches that believers will **reign with Christ** in His kingdom. This suggests that believers will have some kind of role or responsibility in God's eternal kingdom.



Drawing Instructions:

Draw five roles of governance representing priests, judges, servants, heirs, and appointed governance roles by God in heaven.



4.3. A Place of Fellowship

Mat 8:10-11 When Jesus heard this, he was astin...read all.

Drawing Instructions:

Draw a table and feast with twelve people around the table. Give each of the twelve a name of someone you would like to meet once you reach heaven. This represents your fellowship with people when you reach heaven.

Who would you like to spend time with in heaven?

(Consider the heroes that you admire in your daily life, people of the Bible, friends and family)

HEART QUESTIONS:

What does the type of people you want to spend time with tell you about yourself?









(Reflect on who the people are that you can encourage and learn from in heaven.)

Set up time with people who can influence you to grow spiritually today? (1Co 15:31)

5. UNIMAGINABLY AWESOME

Heaven will be a place of peace when the governance and citizenship are perfect in every way.

5.1. No Sorrow

Rev 21:4 'He will wipe every tear from their eyes.read all.

Drawing Instructions:

Draw a Victory cup, and write "Reward", Mat 16:27, 1Co 2:9 (representing those rewarded by God).



HEART QUESTIONS:

What hardships are you looking forward to God removing when you are in heaven?

(God will remove all sorrow, pain, loss, death, and suffering. In heaven, all the pain and struggles of this life will be gone, and we will experience perfect peace and healing.)







5.2. Never Hunger or Thirst

Rev 7:16-17 'Never again will they hunger; ...read all.

Drawing Instructions:

Draw a Food Basket and write "Food", presenting how God will preserve heaven from corruption.



What was the punishment God brought over Adam and Eve?
Where will the Lamb be, and what will he be doing?
The Lamb, Jesus, will be at the centre of God's throne, shepherding His people and leading them to springs of living water.
HEART QUESTIONS:
What are you looking forward to in heaven?
Write a prayer of gratitude for the rewards that God has promised in heaven, and reflect on how you can live in a way that reflects those promises.





5.3. No Corruption or Deterioration

Mat 6:19-20 But store up for yourselves treasures ...read all.

Drawing Instructions:

Draw a Crown labelled "Ruler", representing how God will keep the heavens from corruption.



What is the currency of heaven?

The currency of heaven is not material wealth, but spiritual treasures such as baptised people, our faith, love, obedience, and righteousness.

HEART QUESTIONS:

What is the currency that motivates you the most? What is your hearts desire?

(Reflect on your personal relationship with God. How are you storing up spiritual treasures through your faith and actions?)







5.4.

Unimaginably Awesome

1Co 2:9 However, as it is written: "What no ... read all.

Drawing Instructions:

Draw a "Heart" and write "Awesome" that represents how God will amaze us with his glory.



What could some of the things be that no mind can conceive?

Heaven will surpass anything we can imagine. It could include an indescribable beauty, peace, joy, and closeness with God, beyond what we've ever experienced or envisioned.

6. INTO PRACTICE

6.1. WEEKLY ACCOUNTABILITY

Now that you've learned about eternal rewards, it's essential to think about how you are applying these teachings to your daily life. As the Scripture says in 1 Corinthians 8:1, knowledge by itself isn't enough—true growth comes through love and action. Reflect on the following:

- Are you living as if you will be receiving a reward from God?
- Have you taught believers and non-believers about Eternal Judgement -Reward?

Take a moment to reflect on what you've learned about God's promises and eternal rewards. How does this understanding change the way you live your life today?



6.3. MEMORY VERSE



Don't try and learn all the memory verses at once, but only select one or two verses each week. Go at a pace that doesn't add too much pressure on yourself and others. You will find new meaning of the scriptures you memorise.

Joh 14:1 "Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in me. 2 In my Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am. 4 You know the way to the place where I am going."

Eph 3:19 And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, 18 may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, 19 and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

Rev 21:3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Now the dwelling of God is with men, and he will live with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. 4 He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away."
